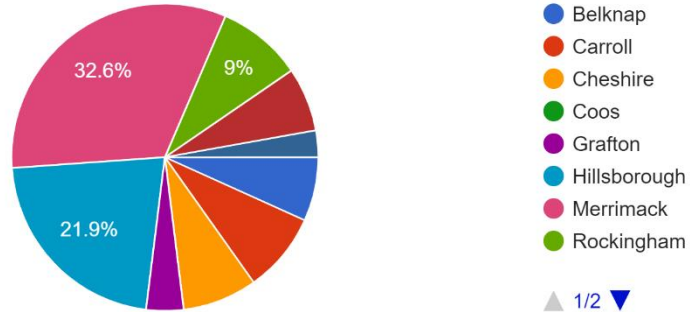

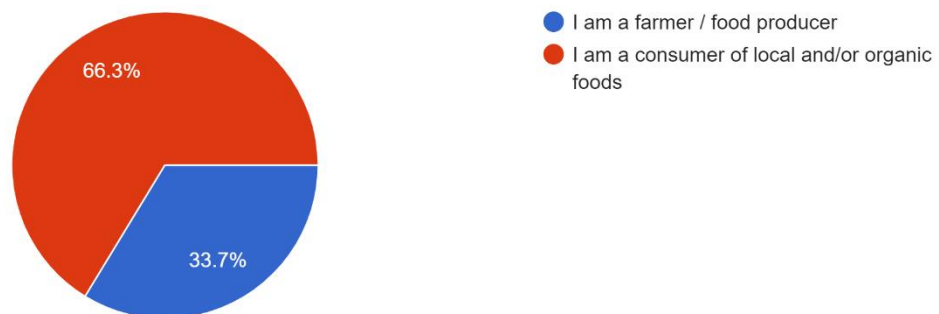
In what NH county do you reside?

Which best describes your responses?

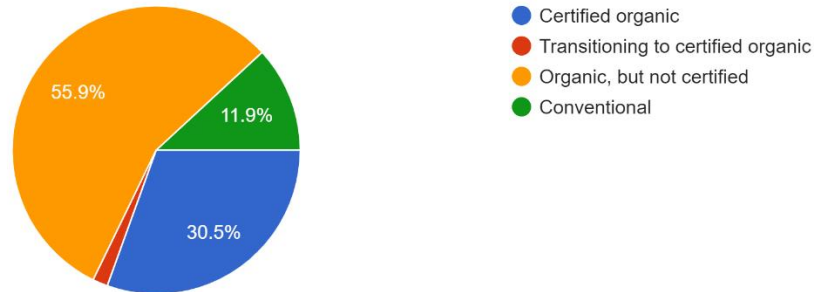

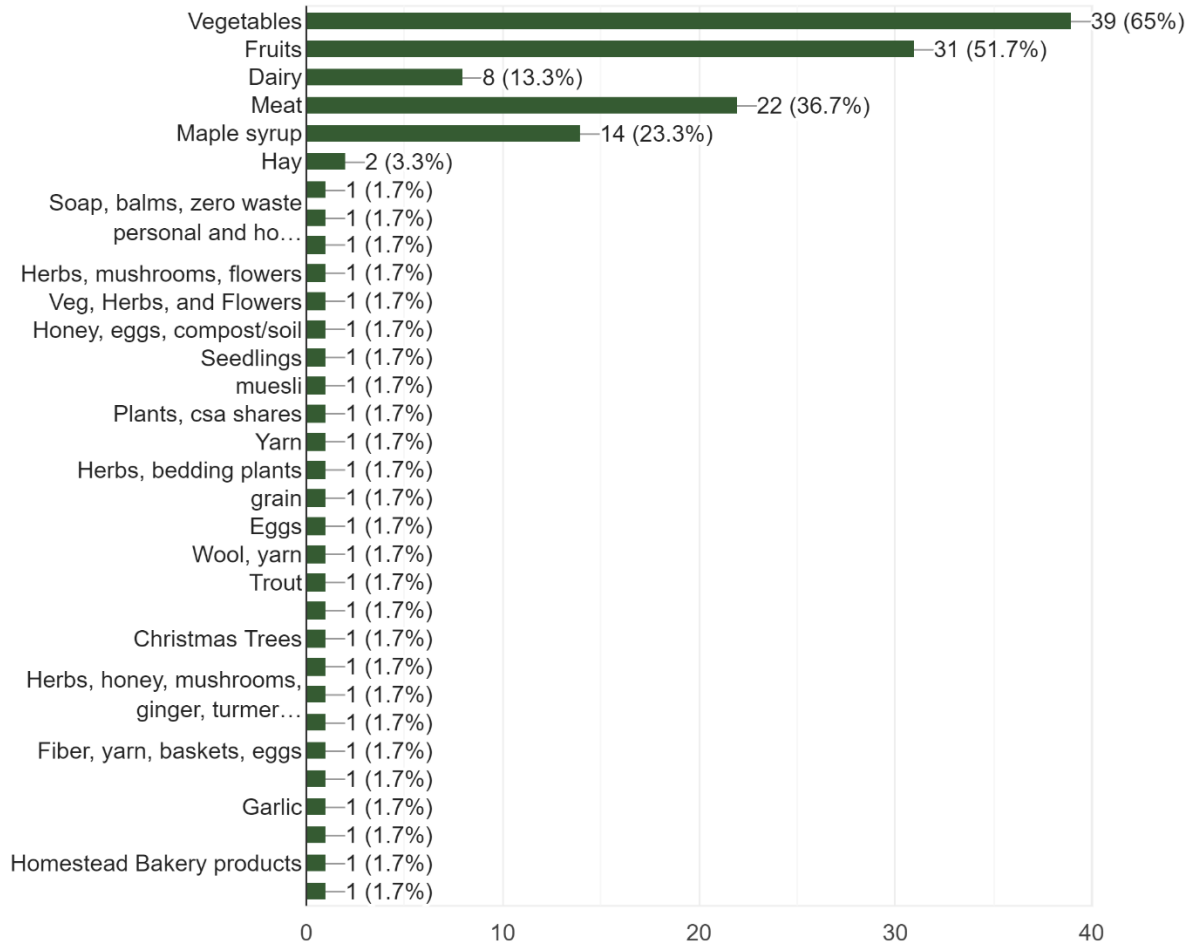
Which best describes the farming practices you use?

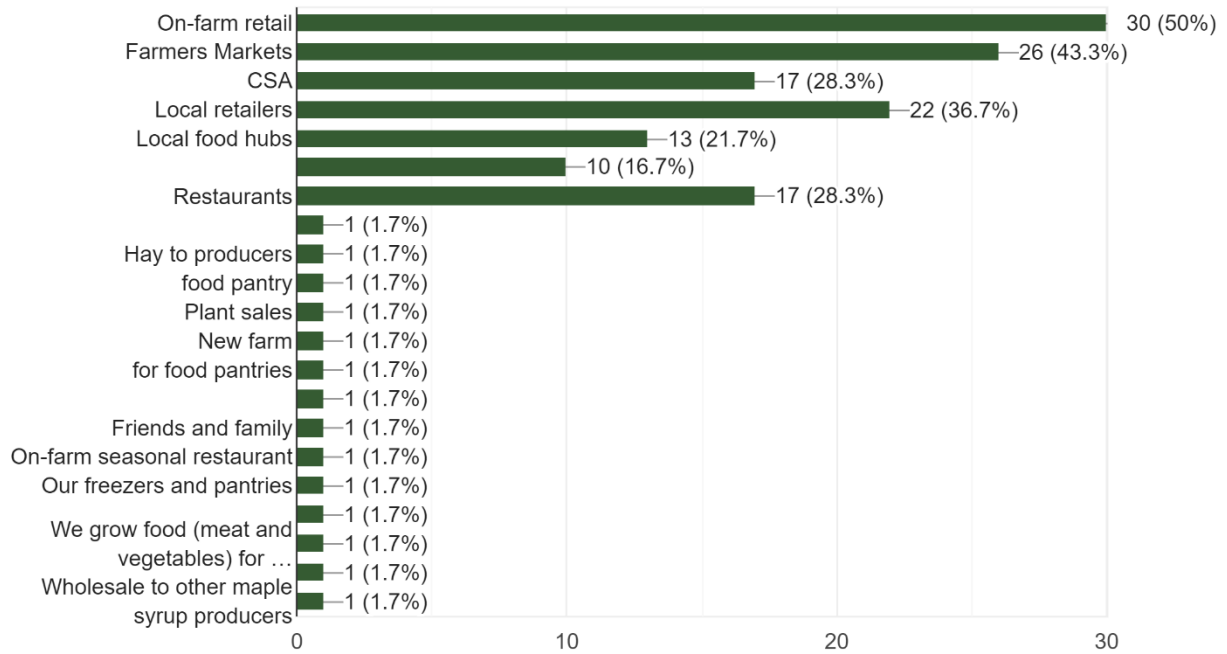
What does your farm produce and sell? Select all that apply.

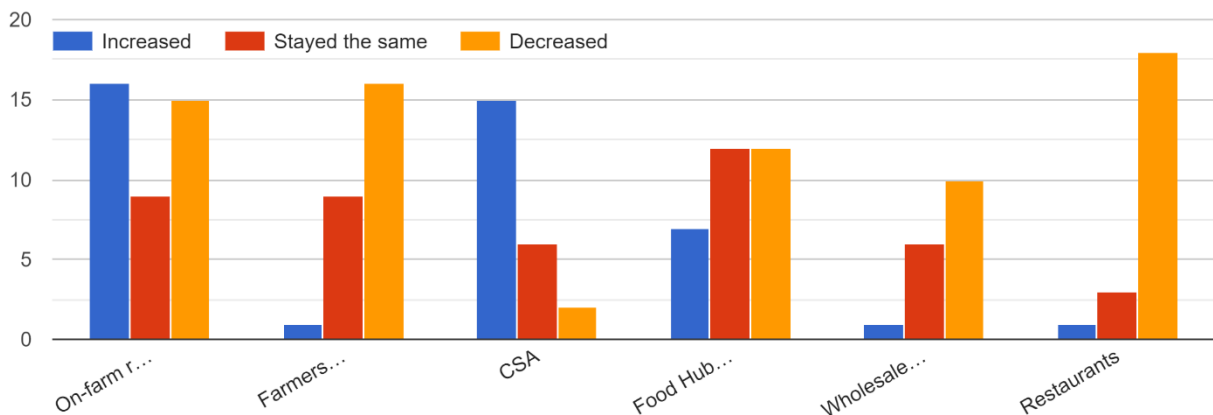


In 2019, what were the main outlets for your products prior to COVID-19? Select all that apply.

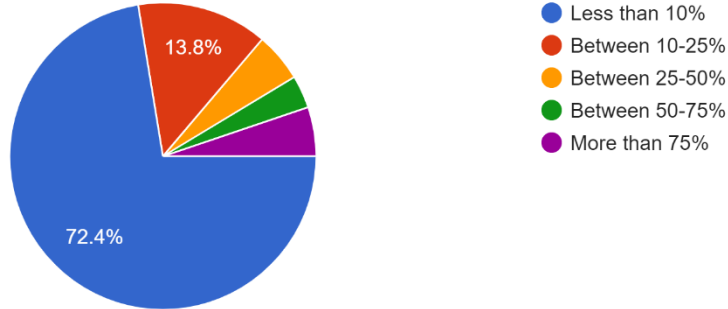


Since the NH "Stay at Home" order was issued on March 27, 2020, what changes have you seen to your product outlets (Increase / Decrease / Same)?



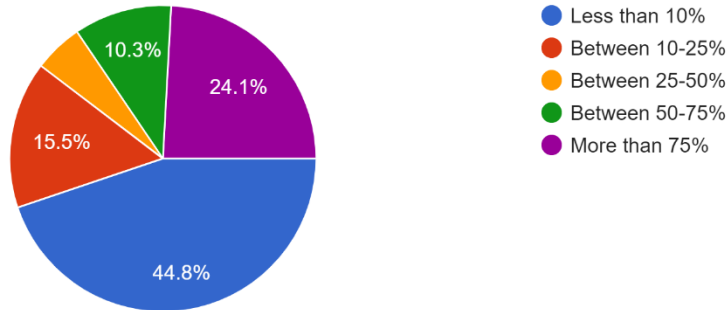
In 2019, roughly what percentage of your product sales transactions were done on-line or by phone?

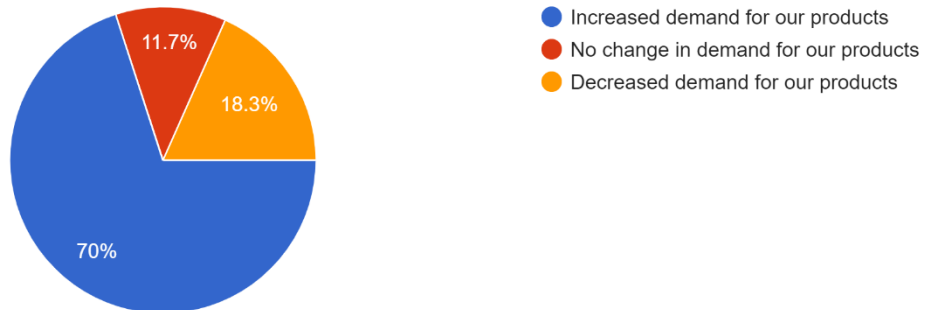

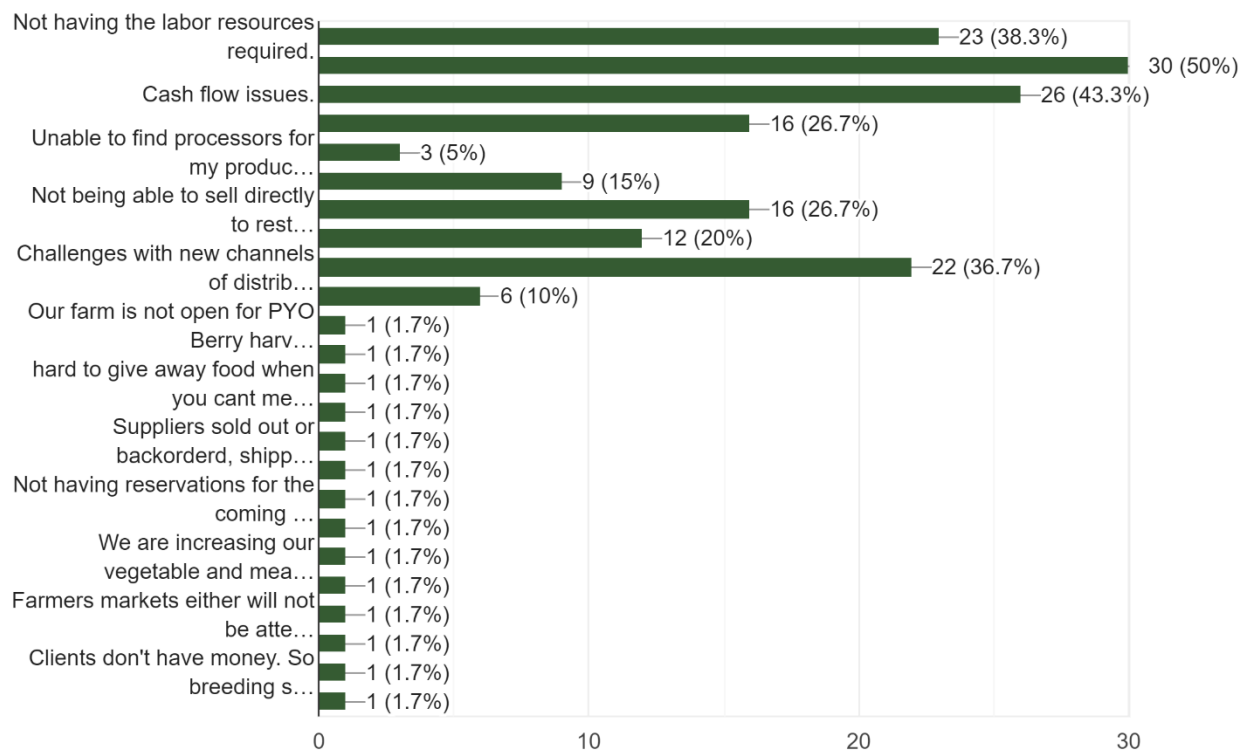

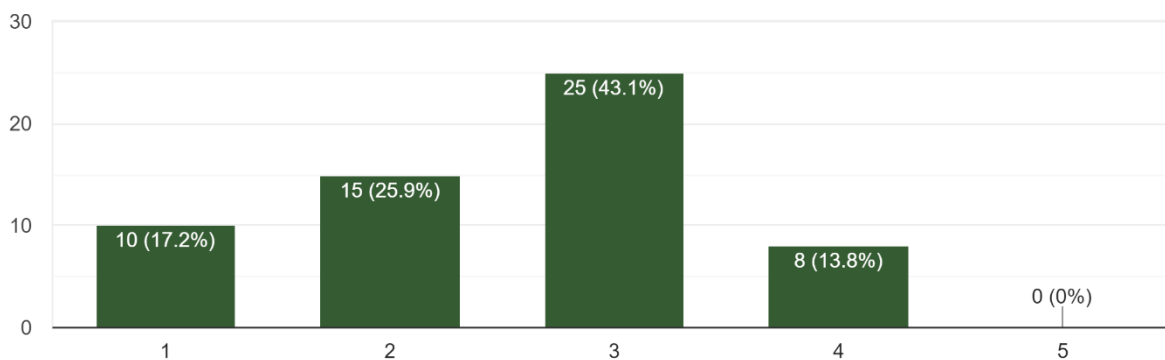
Which best describes your existing farm/food business situation due to disruption from the COVID-19 crisis? (Select all that apply.)

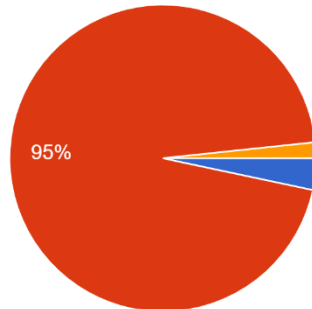

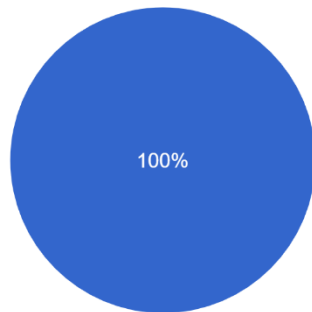

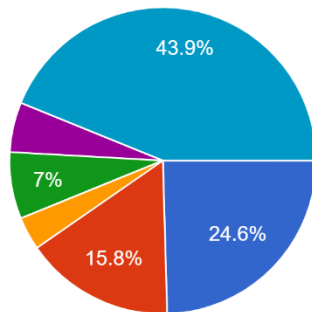

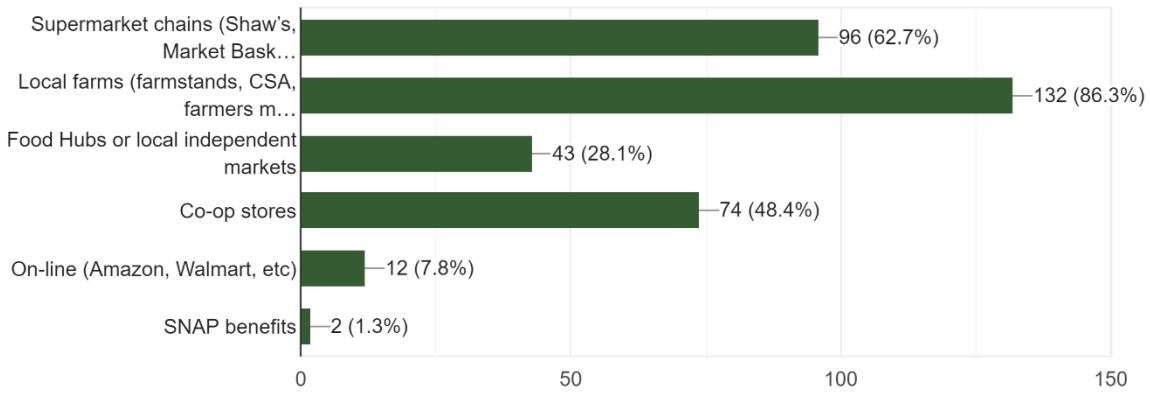

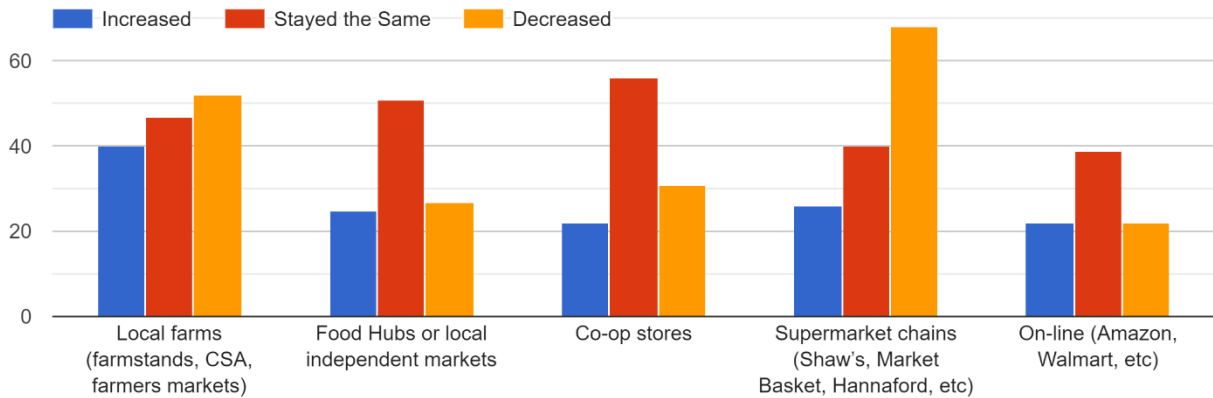

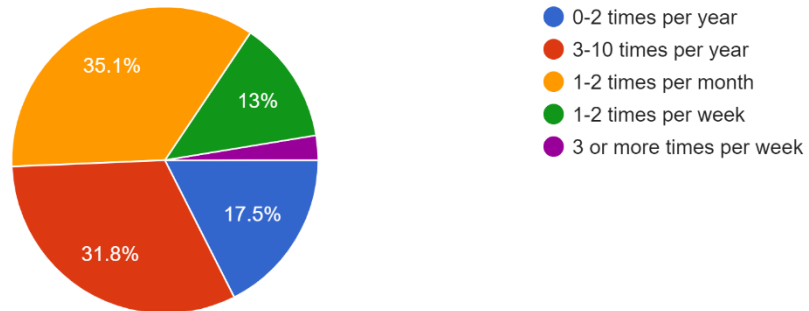

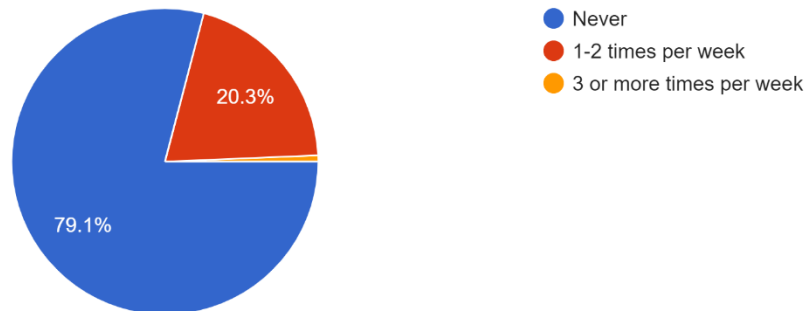
In 2019, approximately how often did you eat at restaurants that clearly supported NH local and/or organic farms?

Since the NH “Stay at Home” order was issued on March 27, 2020, approximately how often do you order food from restaurants that clearly support NH local and/or organic farms?

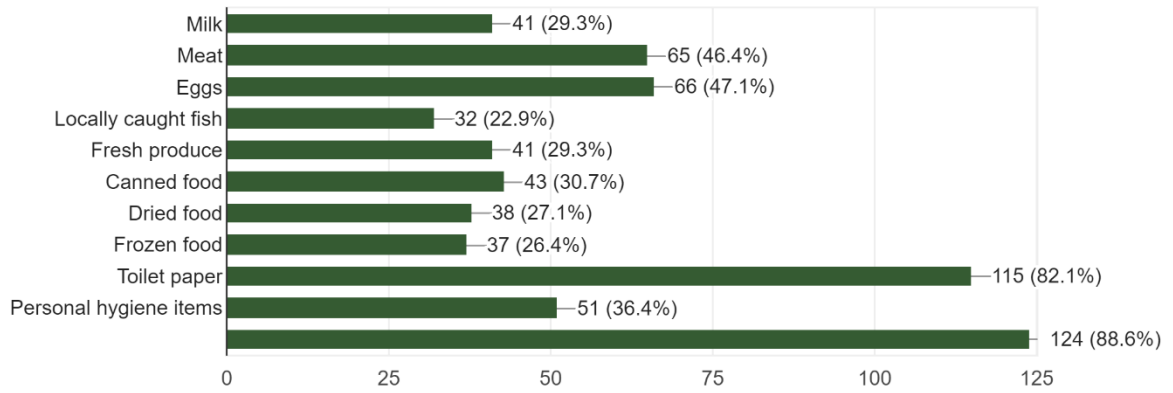
