



NOFA-NH Farm Share Program 2022 Report

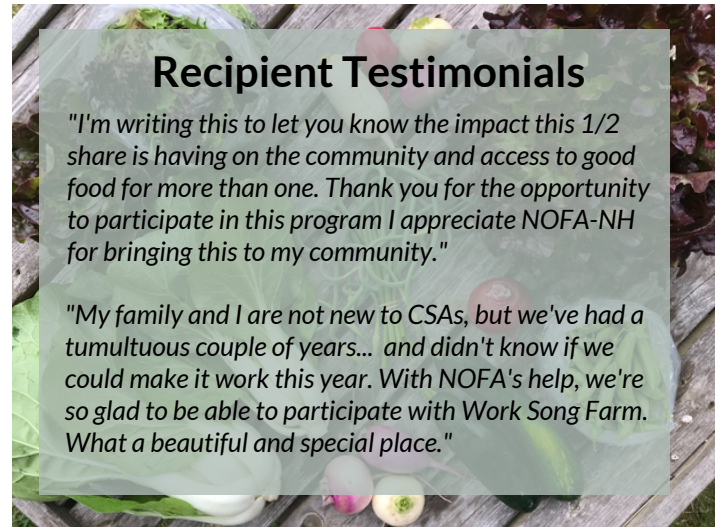
This program provides funds for limited-income NH residents to purchase CSA shares, also known as farm shares, at a discounted rate from certified organic farms.

160+ people received 75% off their CSA shares

50 shares distributed in 8 counties
